26 ^h April	Sunshine Coast Hinterland Great Walk- Baroon Pocket to Kondalilla Falls Car pooling required	This track starts at the Baroon Pocket Dam and passes through open woodland ridges. It crosses bridges and boardwalks over palm-lined streams. Narrows lookout provides a splendid view into the Narrows Gorge. The Baroon lookout (2.2km along) offers views of Obi Obi Gorge, Baroon Pocket Dam and its catchment. Either return or continue along past Flat Rock and come out at Kondalilla Falls.	
22 nd – 24 th May	O'Reillys Lamington National Park Camping & various hikes	Meet Friday evening at O'Reilly's campground. Book own site. Various walks from here, both longer & shorter. Plan for a picnic & exploring of rock pools too. Car shuffle or bus

Girraween, a park of massive granite outcrops, large angular tors, and precariously balanced boulders. Spectacular wildflower displays splash colour among the granite in spring. Great walks of varying lengths & difficulties Book own campsite - further details closer to time	
25th October	Summer Falls (from Sunday Creek Rd) Connondale National Park 13 KM return	Summer Falls are part of the Great Connondale Great Walk. Trek from Sunday Creek Rd to the Falls. Walking through native eucalypt forest on an undulating path but it's not hard work. The trail follows along the top of forest ridges, up high and dry before descending to the Falls
